Study Abroad Without Leaving the Country

Chinese Summer Camp is a unique full day immersion educational program that builds competency in Chinese language, provides a hands-on understanding and appreciation of Chinese culture. A rich program covering Chinese, Math, Science, Arts/crafts, etc, flexible drop off and pickup schedule, affordable tuition, course design based on individual needs.

Each session includes daily planned activities and outdoor/indoor exercises that involve Chines music, song, dance, crafts, sports, games, art, workshops, painting, and field trips.

Program Description:

1. <u>**Two Chinese Language units**</u>: With a focus on kids' overall four Chinese proficiency areas, drilling their Chinese communication skills and elevating their reading and writing ability.

2. <u>Math Curriculum</u> is based on student interest and levels, including but not limited to PSAT/SAT math questions, math contest (Olympiad and/or MathCounts) preparation, and puzzles. This course will be taught in English.

3. Video Game Design and Computer Game Programming Class will demonstrate how to program a video game, in a hope to inspire the imagination and creativity of students so they are motivated to either develop their own game from scratch.Free programming software will be used in class but students should bring their own equipment such as laptop. (Age:10-14)

4. <u>Chinese Culture</u>: Chinese calligraphy, painting, handcrafts, foods, martial arts, dancing, and Chinese songs, music, along which related Chinese geography and history will be introduced to the students.

5. <u>Chinese Theater Play or puppet show</u>: each student will be assigned with a role in a Chinese theater play. At the end of summer section, students will perform at the celebration (parents are invited).

Class Levels:

 Beginner Class:

 Maximum 15 students, at least 6 years old or finished Kindergarten

 Intermediate Class:

 Maximum 15 students, at least 8 years old.

 Advanced Class:

 Maximum 15 students, at least 10 years old.

Senior Student Volunteers/Internship:

Volunteer and internship opportunities are available to students older than 15 years old (by July 1, 2014). Preference will be given to students who can speak fluent Chinese. Applicants can stop by at Principal's office during Chinese school time or send us a brief letter of interest.
